New Business

Shower Trailer Ministry- Don Dobson has faithfully led the Shower Trailer Ministry for the last several years. Due to his age and health issues the network has tried to fill his position. That endeavor has been unsuccessful. David Barron has been researching what the network should do with the Shower Trailer and truck.

A motion was made to donate the Shower Trailer to the KBC to be used in Cadiz, KY for a youth camp and sell the truck. The money for the truck will be used for another ministry opportunity and put in the Shower Trailer account.

Old Business

Georgetown Baptist Affiliation- At the May Leadership Team Meeting, the Leadership Team authorized Executive Director David Stokes and Affiliation Specialist Steve Broughton to investigate if Georgetown Baptist should be removed from Network affiliation. Georgetown Baptist has been found to be in violation of Article 4 Section 2 of the Network Constitution regarding Marriage and Sexuality and Article 5 Section 2 regarding Dismissal of Affiliation. Georgetown Baptist declined to meet with us and are moving forward with their plan to not be affiliated with the Network. A recommendation was made to the Leadership Team that Georgetown Baptist no longer be considered in good standing within the Network and be removed from affiliation with the Network. The Leadership Team will make this recommendation at the October Executive Committee Gathering.
